

Court-Ordered Community Service Positions & Qualifications For St. Vincent de Paul of Seattle | King County

We have three departments at St. Vincent de Paul that accept applicants for court-ordered community service. Those include Thrift Stores, Food bank, and Warehouse/Recycling departments. There are different criteria for each department and availability depends on the current needs of the specific department.

Volunteer in St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Stores

To volunteer in our Thrift stores, you must have a minimum of 30 hours of community service, be able to stand on your feet for extended periods of time, able to lift and carry items of various weights, and have no allergies to dust, dirt, or pet hair. Thrift store hours are 9 a. m. – 7 p. m. Monday – Friday and 10 a. m. – 6 p. m. Saturday and Sunday. You must be able to commit a minimum of four hours per shift. Weekend hours offer the most available positions.

Volunteer in St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank

To be eligible to work in our Food bank, you must have a minimum of eight hours of community service, be available to work on Tuesday or Thursday during the hours of 9 a. m. - 3 p. m. and be able to stand on your feet for extended periods of time. A minimum of four hours per shift is required.

Volunteer in St. Vincent de Paul Warehouse & Recycling

To be eligible to work in our Warehouse/Recycling department, you must have a minimum of eight hours of community service, be able to lift up to 50 pounds, be comfortable working outdoors, and be able to commit to a minimum of four hours per shift. Available hours are from 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday - Friday.
