

According to Forbes, St. Vincent de Paul is the 75th largest charity in the United States. In 2023 in Seattle-King County, St. Vincent de Paul provided \$2.7 million in rent and utility assistance alone to help prevent family evictions and reduce homelessness.

YOUR IMPACT

Your support funds critical social service programs.

GEORGETOWN FOOD BANK

The Georgetown Food Bank and Community Center serves neighbors by providing food, free clothing, health checkups, resource assistance, and a community connector program that serves neighbors with outside resources.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Case managers help neighbors gain access to resources while providing services to those overcoming addiction, mental illness, unemployment, homelessness, and returning to lives of self-sufficiency.

HELPLINE

The Helpline connects those in desperate need of housing solutions, rent and utility assistance, and basic needs with supportive programs and services.

CENTRO RENDU

Centro Rendu provides Latino families with culturally relevant programs, including early childhood education, academic support, case management, legal advocacy, job training, and leadership development.

PERSON-TO-PERSON VISITS

Vincentian volunteers, in 48 neighborhood-based teams, make over 16,000 person-to-person visits annually, assisting families and individuals with rent, utilities, food & other basic needs.

HOW IT WORKS

As a Table Captain, you will:

- Collect 7 guests to sit with you at your table by sharing why supporting St. Vincent de Paul is so important to you and to neighbors in our community who are low-income or experiencing homelessness.
- Invite your family members, friends, fellow parishioners, and/or colleagues.

Keep track of your progress:

- Confirm with your guests by email or phone after they have accepted your invitation.

- Arrive by 7:30 a.m. to locate your table and greet your guests as they arrive.
- Review your Table Captain packet, which will include pledge cards, envelopes, and pens for your guests to use during the 'ask for donations'.
- Collect the completed envelopes from your guests and leave your packet on the table (our finance team will collect the packets from the tables).
