Last week was not unlike others. We received a call to our SVdP Helpline from a 19-year-old single mother. She needed help to pay her rent because her baby, Leo, had been sick, and she had lost work hours caring for him. When she called us, we arranged a home visit with her.

Taking the time to visit and listen, we learned much about her hopes and dreams. She wanted to go back to school to attain her high school diploma. We also observed that Leo seemed to be behind in his speech. Quickly, we arranged resources for baby and mom through an

SVdP case manager, while also helping to advocate with the landlord and pay the last \$500 needed to stabilize this young woman who was evidently a wonderful mom with so much potential!"

As we approach this holiday season and settle into winter, we ask that you remember our neighbors who count on your generosity to keep a roof over their heads, food on the table, dry, clean clothes on themselves and their children, and the warmth of hope and love delivered by our staff and volunteers daily to families experiencing isolation.
